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


## REPORT ON "INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY CELEBRATION"





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


### TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION



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## WORLD AIDS DAY CELEBRATION





Dr Vibhuti gavit dean also added her valuable presence. Along with the dignitaries all the HOD's of every department made themselves available for the orientation programme.






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# SWACHATA HI SEVA ABHIYAN PROGRAMME






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
